UC CALIFORNIA NATURALIST CERTIFICATION COURSE

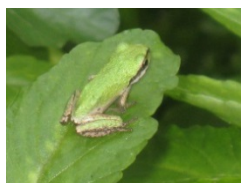
If you enjoy exploring and learning about our local ecology, engaging in participatory science and sharing your knowledge with others, this program is for you! The 40 hour course combines a science curriculum with guest lecturers, field trips and project-based learning to explore the unique ecology and natural history of coastal north San Diego County.



Evening (5:30-8:30 pm) classes will be held at the Buena Vista Nature Center in Oceanside on Tuesdays starting on Feb 4th, 2025 through April 8th. Four mandatory Saturday and two optional field trips are planned at different preserves in our area. Each participant will complete a

Stewardship Project and present his/her/their results to the class.

This course is being offered by Preserve Calavera in collaboration with Buena Vista Audubon. The lead instructors are Jimmy Kidd and Lisa Kuleto.



Fee: Registration is \$260. A limited number of need-based scholarships are available (please email us if interested). Students must purchase [The California Naturalist Handbook](#) (2013, UC Press). Four UC academic credits are available at the completion of the class for \$85. Registration

is limited to the first 20 applicants.
